Google Scholar is a specialized Google search which includes journal articles, books, conference papers, government documents, research reports, grey literature, and other academic material from the websites of universities and researchers. It is Google's attempt to make a library database, like Academic Search Premier, JSTOR, or ABI/Inform.

Not everything in Google Scholar is available online. Some of the documents have been posted for free on the Internet, some are available with a subscription or fee, and some aren't available online at all.

You can configure Google Scholar to know that you are a University of Baltimore student, staff, or faculty member. This will give you access to Langsdale Library's journal subscriptions, increasing the amount of full text you'll find in Google Scholar.

Here's how you do it:


1. Go to <http://scholar.google.com>



2. Click on "Scholar Preferences."




3. On the Scholar Preferences page, go to “Library Links” and type “University of Baltimore.”



5. Scroll up to the top of the screen and click “Save Preferences.”
